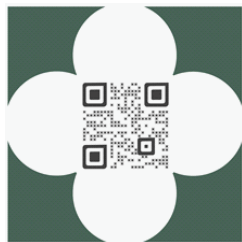

Please take a moment to turn your cell phone ringer off. Thank you!

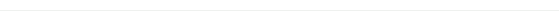

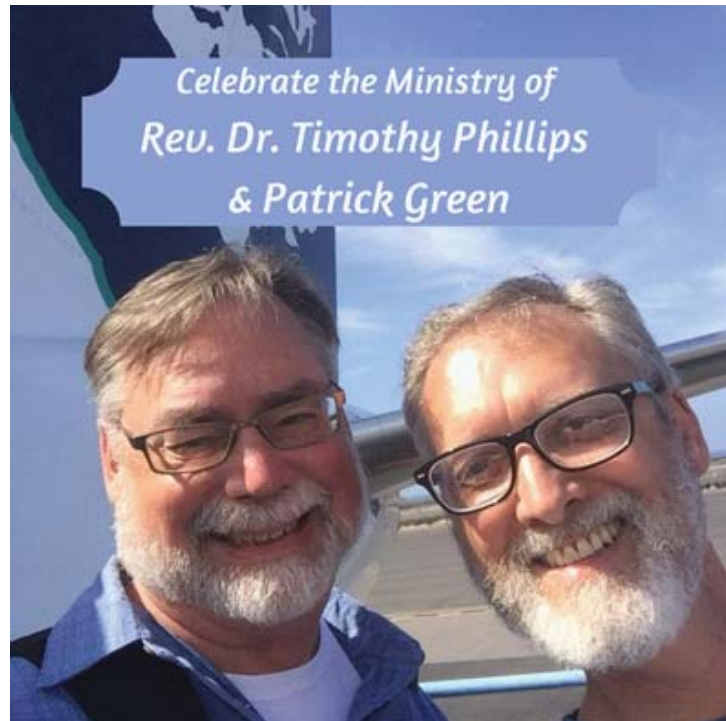
