The event is titled **JUNETEENTH –The Songs of Black Folk: Music of Resistance and Hope**. **The concert will expose the audience to Negro Spirituals** and the diverse musical traditions that have spun off from them, including Gospel, jazz, R&B, and even Hip-Hop.
