

Dave Roberts' description of our baptistry banner for Advent: How does a weary world rejoice? In the paper art piece see a sun that is a constant we can depend on, no matter the weather externally or internally. It helps sustain the growth that surrounds the main feature of the piece. Branches hold peace and love and new growth. There's a symbol of Christ's invitation to all to come to the table, represented by a goblet and a cross. New life is surrounded by care and nurture, with the seed of new life coming to those who nurture as well. Probably more difficult to see at a distance is a scale of justice and the words "Hope", "Joy", "Life" and "Holy", all of which provide avenues for rejoicing if we choose to see them.
